Language Perfect at Wattle Park Primary

From the 20th May to 30th May, the students at Wattle Park Primary School, participated in the Language Perfect World Championships 2013. They also participated in the NEVR Vocab Slam – the North Eastern Victoria Region Vocab Slam. In these ten days, there were a total of 549,859 questions answered by the Wattle Park Primary School community.

As a result of the students persistence and hard work the following awards were won by Wattle Park Primary students;

1. The Number 1 school in Victoria for Chinese
2. The Number 1 school in the NEVR for languages
3. The Number 1 class in the NEVR for languages – 5N
4. The Number 1 student in the NEVR for languages – Andre T from 5N
5. The 99 certificates ranging from credits, to bronze, to silver and to gold.
