## Just a reminder from the First Aid room...

Cold and Flu season is upon us and many children are coming to school with bad coughs and sniffles.

### This advice from the Victorian Department of Health

- Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when you cough or sneeze.
- Throw the tissue in a plastic-lined rubbish bin after use.
- Wash your hands with soap and water after you cough or sneeze.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth as germs spread that way.
- Don't go to work if you are unwell and **don't send your children to school or child care if they are unwell.**
