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ENVELOPE AND ORDER INSTRUCTIONS

Dear Parents & StudentsPHOTO DAY IS Wednesday 22nd May

School photo order envelopes have been or will be distributed to every student and it is important that the order instructions (below) are followed.

Important Information

- Every student ordering photos must return an order envelope before photo day.
- Every student ordering photos must return their own order envelope – even if their payment is in their sibling's envelope.
- Sibling photo order envelopes can be collected from the school office and must be returned to the school office before photo day.
- Orders placed after photo day will be charged a late order fee.

Order Instructions

1. **Select a photo package option** - each option is explained on the flyer attached to the order envelope.
2. **Complete your order envelope** - use a black or blue ball point pen and fill in your order and contact details.
3. **Complete payment** - using one of the following options.

CASH

- Put exact money in order envelope.
- *No change* will be given.
- You can pay for all siblings in one order envelope - you must write on each order envelope the name and class of the sibling that has payment.

CHEQUE

- Write your name, address and telephone number on the back of the cheque.
- Dishonour fees will be charged if payment is declined.
- Make cheques payable to:
ADVANCEDLIFE PHOTOGRAPHY
- Allow up to 60 days for payment to be completed.

CREDIT CARD

- Payment can *only* be made online.
 1. Go to website: www.advancedlife.com.au
 2. Click on *online payments and re-orders*, then click on *proceed*
 3. Enter the three (3) letter online payment code found on your order envelope (example: SCH), then click on OK
 4. Follow the payment instructions
 5. Write your receipt number on your order envelope under payment method – online payment.
- You can pay for all siblings in one transaction – you must total the amount of all order envelopes and write the receipt number on each order envelope.
- Return order envelope to school *before* photo day.

Next Buildings and Grounds Committee Meeting Tuesday 7th May 7:30pm School Staff Room.

The Buildings and Grounds Committee meet approximately once a month to plan and implement essential school ground maintenance and development work. We are working toward a more sustainable school that caters for sport, free play, outdoor education and biodiversity whilst providing a safe environment for our children to enjoy.

In 2012 and early 2013 a Landscape Masterplan was developed and has now been finalised and approved by School Council. The B&G committee will be working toward implementing this plan (over several years) in addition to general maintenance around the school.

To do this we need a range of skilled and non-skilled people to volunteer at working bees and/or to complete particular projects, help us to apply for grants and provide expertise or just generally help out.

Some of the projects we would like to complete in 2013/2014 include: Turfing the top oval, landscaping in front of the gym, planting an avenue of trees, installing and maintaining drains, building and fixing the stairs up to the top oval, building shade/rain shelters around the lower ball court.

One of the major maintenance items we will need to do in the near future is to replace a section of roof guttering on the main office building – there is hardly any gutter left! And whilst we love our tall trees the gutters pay the price and need cleaning out every month to stop them overflowing during and rain and flooding into the class rooms. Installing leaf guard on the gutters is currently beyond the schools finances but if there is someone out there with the appropriate skills then it would be great to have them come forward to volunteer some expertise and time. As a safety requirement all roof level work needs to be completed by a skilled and insured person who knows what they are doing.

Likewise general landscaping, paving and building skills are in great demand – please come forward and lend a hand.
