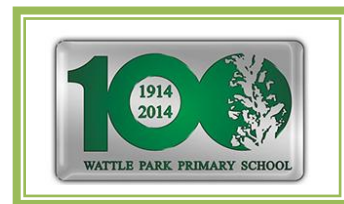

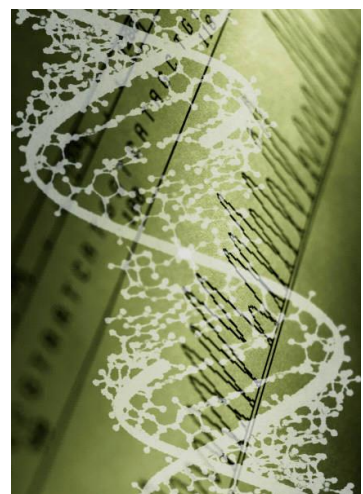
The Education Committee is a sub-committee of the Wattle Park School Council. The committee's role is to:

Wattle Park is going mobile with Konnective is a mobile app solution that will allow us to communicate with you, our parents, straight to your smartphone. You will be able to receive important alerts (similar to a text message) as soon as they are released.
