※ MORNING ROUTINE ※

HOME READERS

It continues to be very important that daily home reading becomes part of your routine. Please sign the reading log each time your child has finished reading their book. Your child will be responsible for changing their reader and selecting a new book each day.

INTEGRATED UNITS

Year 1 – "Rock Pool Discovery"

Students will explore different creatures and plants that inhabit a rock pool environment. As part of this unit, there will be an educational experience to Rickett's Point (Monday 25th March – approx. cost \$15.06) and a Wild Action incursion (Friday 15th March – approx. cost \$13.62).

Year 2 - "Under the Sea"

Students will investigate different creatures that live in the ocean. As part of this unit, there will be an educational experience to the Melbourne Aquarium (Thursday 21^{st} March – approx. cost \$31.86).

YEAR 1 - CAMERON CLOSE READING

A special feature of the Year 1 English program is visiting Cameron Close, where students take a favourite book or take-home reader to share with a group of residents. Each Year 1 class will visit every Wednesday on a rotating basis throughout the year. The students eagerly look forward to their visits and develop close connections with the residents, who so generously give their time.
